3. HAZARDS IDENTIFICATION

EMERGENCY OVERVIEW

Clear to Slightly Hazy, Colorless Liquid. Mild Odor. Causes Eye Burns and Skin Irritation. Harmful if Swallowed.

EFFECTS OF ACUTE EXPOSURE

EYES:

Causes eye burns. Symptoms may include pain, tearing, redness, and eye injury.

SKIN:

Causes severe skin irritation. Symptoms may include pain, redness, rash, and swelling.

High concentrations of vapor or mist may cause nose, throat and respiratory tract irritation. Symptoms may include coughing and a burning sensation in the nose and throat.

INGESTION:

Harmful if swallowed. May cause mouth, throat and stomach burns. Symptoms may include nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, and severe stomach pain.

Prolonged or repeated contact may cause skin irritation.

4. FIRST AID MEASURES

EYES:

Immediately flush eyes with plenty of water while holding eyelids apart. After initial flushing, remove any contact lenses and continue flushing for at least 15 minutes. Do not put any medication in the victim's eyes unless instructed by a physician. Get immediate medical attention.

SKIN:

Immediatley flush with plenty of water, then wash with soap and water. Remove saturated clothing. Get medical attention if irritation develops or persists. Thoroughly wash (or discard) clothing and shoes before reuse.

INHALATION:

Remove to fresh air. If not breathing, give respiration; if breathing is difficult, give oxygen (by trained personnel only). Get medical attention if symptoms persist.

INGESTION:

Do not induce vomiting. Drink large quantities of water. Get immediate medical attention. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.


